From the Pastor's Desk

TODAY'S GOSPEL: While underlining how Jesus fulfilled ancient scriptural promises, Matthew described his proclamation that the fullness of time had dawned, that God's hopes for the world were in the process of coming to completion. Believing in that message would necessarily usher people into a process of metanoia (repentance), a thorough, astonishing reorientation of belief, thinking and action. After his time of tempting in the desert, Jesus showed no intention of carrying out his mission alone. We are told that upon hearing the invitation, the first disciples took him up on it with all the abandon and enthusiasm of people who are falling in love. Today, we are invited to remember our moments of metanoia and reflect on how we have integrated them into the project of our lives. By no means is everyone called to leave behind their metaphorical nets and travel as apostolic disciples. Yet, Emmanuel calls all who bear the name Christian to so believe that the reign of God is among us that we center our lives publicly around that astounding truth.


