- 1) Adults **75 years** of age and older, or who will be turning 75 in 2021.
- 2) Staff, residents and caregivers in retirement homes and other
- congregate care settings\* for seniors.
- 3) Health care workers in the High Priority level, and in accordance with
- the Ministry of Health's guidance on Health Care Worker Prioritization.
- 4) All Indigenous adults and adult household members.
- 5) Adult recipients of chronic home care.

Note: care providers and family members of chronic home care patients are not eligible at this time.

\*Congregate care settings include those with shared amenities (including shared rooms, bathrooms, kitchen, dining area, etc.)


