

TODAY'S GOSPEL: Like the disciples after the Ascension, we have also known moments of wondering why God seems to have disappeared, leaving such a trifling group as us to carry on His mission. Today, we are called to remember who we are. We are the baptized. We have received the Spirit. Yet our temptation is to keep looking to heaven instead of trusting Christ's judgment and taking the mission into our own hands. Most of all, as a "lover of God" community, we have been entrusted with Jesus' mission for our time and place. St. Paul tells us that we can live a life worthy of our call. As Luke shows us, the Ascension is just the beginning. The angels would tell us what they told the group on the mountain: "Stop looking up. It's now your turn, the only one you'll have, to carry on."


