# From the Pastor's Desk

**TODAY'S READINGS:** While we may have the same image of God as Job, like him, we can encounter the majesty of the Creator in creation. Whether captivated by an experience of love, natural beauty, or even sheer amazement at the elegance of math, astronomy, or theology, human nature is open to the mysterious, sometimes overwhelming ways God is present to us. For Job and the psalmists, it often began with **complaint**. For the disciples of today's Gospel, **frightened cries for help** opened them to glimpse who Jesus really was. For Paul, it was the **forgiving and commissioning love** of the one who introduced himself as "Jesus, whom you are persecuting." If St. Paul were to summarize the message of today's liturgy, he might simply say: "If the love of Christ does not impel you, you have not yet met Christ."
