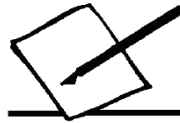

**TODAY'S GOSPEL:** Jesus calls his disciples to demonstrate that the reign of God is at hand. He invites us to risk co-creating a just and loving society. Jesus showed that the goal and ultimate joy of life is to live in union with God and one another, and that those who give their lives away will discover the fullness of life. Instead of offering comfort and safety, our faith puts great expectations on us. Baptism calls each of us to be prophetic, priestly heirs of the creator of the universe. None of us can imagine what will be required of us and it would be absurd and harmful to think we could fulfill it by ourselves. But according to Christianity we, vulnerable bundles of humanity that we are, were created susceptible to God's indwelling Spirit and the power of Christ.
