## From the Pastor's Desk

**TODAY'S GOSPEL:** The miraculous sharing of bread that had happened among the crowd offered the key to understanding Jesus' offer ("I am the bread of life"). When one child gave all he had, they saw that those who share everything will never hunger. If they wanted to do the works of God, if they wanted the food that endures, they needed only to believe in Jesus enough to do what he did. Jesus' sharing of himself as the bread of life illustrates the greatest potential of human life. The Son of God entered our history not to wow us with miracles, but to show us how we can live as St. Paul suggests: as new selves, people truly renewed in spirit. We who love the stories of Jesus can and must take responsibility for them by making them come true in our own day.

**Completed forms may be deposited in the Offertory bag at the entrance of the Church**


