From the Pastor's Desk

TODAY'S GOSPEL: Jesus was called by God through the people who responded to him. As the Son, he learned to act in the name of the God whose love cannot be imposed. What it was like to be Jesus was to be hopeful, generous, capable of much, but able to do only as much as others would accept from him. That is how he was Godlike. The awesome truth of this is that we hold the power to allow Christ to be our shepherd king, our rabonni, or simply an image on a holy card. Bartimaeus moved from asking Jesus to be the healing shepherd king to allowing him to be the teacher who would lead him down the road to total self-giving. As we draw toward the last weeks of our liturgical year, Bartimaeus and the Letter to the Hebrews ask two key questions: "Who do we allow God and Christ to be for us?" and, "What does this call us to do?

SHARE LIFE: Living the Gospel by supporting the Deaf community. We have all felt the pain of disconnection since the start of the pandemic. For the Deaf community, the connections severed by the pandemic are even more profound. Many became isolated from their peers and could no longer access the programs they relied upon. Silent Voice is working to restore these connections. This Share Life-funded agency is the only one in the area providing virtual programming for Deaf children, among its many services in American Sign Language. 
