From the Pastor's Desk

TODAY'S GOSPEL: Pope Francis tells us that our sister Earth is crying out, pleading with us to change course. He says, "Never have we so hurt and mistreated our common home as we have in the last two hundred years. ... [Yet] we still lack the culture needed to confront this crisis." As we begin the season of Advent, we are invited to hear the Scriptures in the light of the signs of our times. Pope Francis wrote Laudato Si' to "help us to acknowledge the appeal, immensity and urgency of the challenge we face." The dual message of ecological catastrophe and divine promise invite us to lift our soul to the God who longs to lead us into salvation. Francis teaches that "humanity still has the ability to work together in building our common home." This first week of Advent promises that the time of salvation is at hand, if only we will dare to ask for divine help and take responsibility for our boomeranging prayer.

<u>SEASON OF ADVENT:</u> Advent has a two-fold nature. It prepares us for Christmas, when we recall Christ's first coming among us, and it is also a time when we look forward to his second coming at the end of the ages. Advent is a season of joyful expectation.




