From the Pastor's Desk

THE NATIVITY OF THE LORD: Christmas – the birth of Christ – heralds the beginning of our salvation. In the darkness of the night, God's purest light appeared in time, offering us a share in his eternal life through a newborn child who is *Emmanuel:* God is with us. May Christ who is with us always, bless you and keep you in his care during this holy season and all year round.

FEAST OF THE HOLY FAMILY: The feast of the Holy Family invites us to celebrate our relationships with those we love most deeply. It reminds us that the greatest gift we can give others is to respect and nurture their freedom to become all God has created them to be. 


