From the Pastor's Desk

TODAY'S GOSPEL: The prophetic word is a graced word, and no matter how searing it may be, it always invites transformation. The Gospel account reminds us that prophets are not accepted in their own land because prophets shake up the status quo. For those of us who dare to act prophetically like Jeremiah and Jesus in our world hungering for hope, vision and justice, we have the promise of presence — "I am with you to deliver you," says the holy one, whose power working within us continually empowers us for the work to be done. St. Paul reminds us that love is the greatest of all virtues. At the heart of the prophetic mission is an insatiable love for the divine and all creation, making the work of justice ever more compelling and forever alluring.

February 4th – 7 p.m. to Sunday, February 6 – 1 p.m. at Manresa Jesuit Spiritual Renewal Centre. A silent Ignatian weekend retreat for women. 
