From the Pastor's Desk

TODAY'S GOSPEL: When we contemplate God as Trinity, we see God as Father, Son and Spirit creating, being incarnate and pouring self out in us so that they can draw all of creation into divine life. Christians believe that God is a God whose very being is communal love and who created in order to share that love. That means that we who are created in the image of God are created to find our greatest fulfillment as images of the Trinity: enjoying relationships with one another, with God and with all of God's creation. When we realize this, we understand that the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity summarises everything we have been celebrating for the 50 days of Easter.


