From the Pastor's Desk

TODAY'S GOSPEL: Salvation becomes the equivalent of being known by Christ. It is the experience of the people who have walked his way. Being known by Christ requires more than the gestures and rituals of worship. It implies listening so deeply that Christ's word lives in us. Jesus intimates that he really knows only those who have allowed him into their lives so completely that they reflect and actually represent him in their own context. This is Luke's version of "I know mine and mine know me." Whenever we strive to be perfect or focus on sin and forgiveness, we remain the center of our attention. The passage through Jesus' narrow gate takes us beyond self-concern into the realm of knowing we are loved and are therefore free to love any and everyone else. It's not how many will be saved, but how many will let it happen to them?
