## From the Pastor's Desk

TODAY'S GOSPEL: In the contrast between the Magi and Herod's theologians, today's Gospel shows the difference between people who can receive a revelation and those who protect themselves from it. What did the Magi know? They knew that their stores of wisdom, knowledge and certainties were smaller than the truth. The Magi warn us about what Dietrich Bonhoeffer called <a href="cheap grace">cheap grace</a>: the easy answers and religious facts that provide security rather than call us into growth. The Magi had more faith in God than in their own ideas and understanding. We might look to them as reminders that no matter how much we accomplish, learn or love, God keeps offering more to those who are willing to seek and find it. Like the Magi who could leave Herod to his own devices, it's always possible to reorient ourselves. Our journey will not end on this Earth, but we cannot do better than spend our lifetime seeking.


