From the Pastor's Desk

TODAY'S GOSPEL: Water is a precious commodity in the desert. Sharing water symbolizes hospitality, openness to the stranger and respect for life. In an inside out image of the God who can draw water from stone, the vulnerable Jesus must ask for life-giving water and acceptance, and he does it at the well that symbolizes the woman's heritage of faith in the God of Abraham. Once they have begun their conversation, Jesus reveals that the divine thirst is not for water, but for a life-giving relationship with humanity. We could say that salvation springs from relationship with God; it is never bound by any particular deed, creed or ritual. Salvation happens when we attend to God's thirst and respond with personal hospitality. Once we have been affected by a relationship with God, it automatically begins to flow into all our other relationship. Today, the Samaritan Woman may appear to us in many guises. We will recognize her by her enthusiastic love and the way she invites us to respond to God's thirst and enjoy living water forever. Like her, all we need do is respond. As a result, the world's thirst will begin to be quenched.


