From the Pastor's Desk

TODAY'S GOSPEL: In spite of Jesus' love, the disciples knew their own weakness. Jesus recognized their anxiety and promised, "I will not leave you orphans." Helping them face his coming absence, he promised, "I will ask the father ... [for] another Paraclete to be with you always." He promised, "I live and you will live ... You will realize that I am in my Father and you are in me and I in you." As Jesus speaks of the Father and the Spirit, he is inviting us into the love life of the Trinity, the divine community that created the universe simply to share love with creation. Jesus promises that our relationship with God can be like his: "I in my Father and me in you." That union, the grace of baptism, the communion of the Eucharist, are all for the sake of mission. The deeper our love for others, the more passionate we will be for their good. Let us not act like orphans, but be evangelizers who embody the joy of God's Spirit among us.


