TODAY'S GOSPEL: In today's Gospel reading, Jesus celebrates the power of humility as he thanks his Father that his message has come home to the humble. We can imagine Jesus almost dancing with joy as simple people listen to him and get it. These are people who have gotten caught up in the dynamic of Jesus' love and mission. They've been captured by the love of his tender Father. They can face those who disdain them with the self-assurance that comes from knowing they are loved beyond measure. Imagine the freedom of never feeling you had to impress others or demonstrate your worth! (No more being "debtors to the flesh.") 
