

From the Pastor's Desk

TODAY'S GOSPEL: Two of the readings today are about family. The first reading from Genesis sets the stage for the flourishing of the Israelite community. The story's main characters, Abraham and Sarah, are about to start a family, the fulfillment of a promise made to them by the Divine One. In today's Gospel reading from Luke, Mary and Joseph are careful to follow the law of Moses. They fulfill the demands of the ancient purity laws and then fulfill further prescriptions of the law that required them to present their new child to God. For this family, the Jewish laws were important and they kept them as was the custom of the day. From a Christian perspective, we see a shift from the Mosaic Law to the new covenant grounded in an emphasis on love and right relationship. Finally, the reading from Colossians beckons us, as holy and beloved people, to live differently in our world — to embrace compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, patience, forgiveness and above all, love.

SOLEMNITY OF MARY, THE MOTHER OF GOD: Together with all the Sundays of the year, the Solemnity of Mary, the Mother of God (January 1st) is one of the two additional Holy Days of Obligation in the Church calendar. We will have an abbreviated Mass schedule: **Sunday, December 31st at 5:00 p.m. and Monday, January 1st at 10:00 a.m.** (**Please note this Mass change**).


