**TODAY'S GOSPEL:** In today's Gospel, Mark repeats two key ideas: the people were "astonished" or "amazed," and Jesus taught with authority. To citizens of an occupied nation, people who had learned to endure their lot in life, who had grown accustomed to mediocre hopes, Jesus came at them like a thunderstorm in the desert, jolting them out of their tedium. Most people had no idea how to respond. To those who would follow him, Jesus offered an amazing new take on life. He rooted his message in their traditions, yet, rather than close the book saying, "That's all folks!" Jesus spurred them to hope that all the promises of old would come true — in ways so new that they would continually be astounded.
