From the Pastor's Desk

TODAY'S GOSPEL: To emphasize his vine image, Jesus goes on to invite the disciples, <u>"Abide in me as I abide in you."</u> This describes the mutual love he and the disciples share, a love that sustains their life and creates the most intimate relationship possible among them all. Might Barnabas have introduced Paul to his sense of Christ living in him and the limitless breadth of the Body of Christ? For Barnabas, life in Christ seemed to mean that his interior motivation sprang from his union with Christ. He needed no command; he was motivated by a natural and grace-filled impulse. The Sundays of Easter celebrate the resurrection and the union with God that Christ always offers — with or without our knowing it. Whether from faith in Christ or a natural impulse to love, people like Barnabas are fruitful parts of Jesus' vine. They appreciate the fact that they share life with others, and like our servant God, they want all to thrive as best they can


