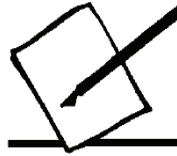

From the Pastor's Desk

TODAY'S FEAST: The Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ invites us to become communion in Christ. Our sisters and brothers in the Eastern churches call this *theosis* or divinization. St. Irenaeus (circa 130-202) was the first great champion of *theosis* which he explained by saying that God became human so that humans might become God. The Eucharist makes us one with God. Our communion in the body and blood involves everything we have and are. With each communion, we repeat our own "I do," to the invitation to strengthen our blood bond with one another and with God, to the invitation to share in the very life of God. As we strive to keep our side of this covenant, we can remain confident because God not only remains faithful, but continually draws us forward toward the day when we all "drink it new in the reign of God." Like the disciples, as we accept God's self-offering by receiving bread and cup, we commit ourselves to unpredictable ways of carrying out Jesus' self-giving: we too offer our body and blood, everything we have and are, as we work and wait for the fulfillment of the reign of God.

MARYGROVE CAMP COLLECTION: Next weekend, June 08/09 there will be a **Special Collection for Marygrove Camp**. The Society of St. Vincent de Paul, Toronto Central Council helps over 1,000 girls each summer, registering eligible campers through home visits. Marygrove Camp is a residential camp situated on Georgian Bay, open to eligible girls ages 5-13. Marygrove provides a camping experience for children who may not otherwise have the opportunity to enjoy a camping adventure. Families who are experiencing financial or domestic hardship may contact the Society directly to determine their eligibility

Here there are Masses and confessions around the clock, blessings with the holy relics by the Jesuit Fathers, devotions and tours of the grounds. The lands have been consecrated by the lives and deaths of the heroic martyrs, both the Jesuit and the Wendat (Huron) Christians, the early Church of Canada, who continue to work from heaven to bring about great good on earth.

STEWARDSHIP: St. Thomas Aquinas says that "the celebration of Holy Mass is as valuable as the death of Jesus on the cross." Therefore, we as stewards should participate in Mass as often as we can because Jesus is waiting to pour out the same love, mercy and grace that he showed on the cross.
