# From the Pastor's Desk

TODAY'S GOSPEL: The little girl restored to life in Mark's Gospel does not experience a *cure*; she experiences a **transformation from** death back to life. And so, death is never the final word. Life is the ultimate desire of the divine as we have heard in the Book of Wisdom and which we now see in Christ's healing touch upon the little girl. In the Gospel narrative, healing involves not only a physical deed but also a belief in the power of the divine to heal. To be spiritually in touch with the divine energy source at the heart of all life and to believe in this divine energy as a force and source for transformative healing is key to the healing and renewal of all life on the planet. In sum, the teaching offered in the Book of Wisdom and the renewed life of a little girl in the Gospel gives hope to a languishing world. The Holy One desires life for all creation, and not just earthly life, but also immortal life. Only in the Book of Wisdom do we hear that the divine, imperishable, immortal Spirit is in all things (Wisdom 12:1).


