Second Sunday of Advent: John the Baptist takes on the role of preparing the time and space for God and the people to encounter one another. Like Isaiah, he calls his people to level the slopes, straighten the curves and smooth the roads of their lives so that they can encounter God's saving power among them. John invited people to experience what he had experienced: the freedom of knowing that God was about to do something great with them. In the words or Baruch, the people who went to John's baptism were symbolically removing their mourning clothes and outfitting themselves to take the road of transformation - of themselves and their history. The thing about genuine conversion or metanoia is that we can't plan it. It is God's offer in a particular moment of history - a grace of insight that shakes us up and turns us around. All we can do is be open to it. So let us gather the willing and accompany one another on the adventure God offers us with this new Advent of the year 2025. The time is right.
