FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Today's readings challenge us to reflect on who Jesus is — and who we are called to be as His disciples. In the Gospel, Jesus asks His disciples, "Who do you say that I am?" This is not just a question for them — it is a question for each of us. If Jesus is truly Lord of our lives, then that reality must shape how we live. He tells us plainly: "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross daily, and follow me." The stewardship way of life is our response to that call. 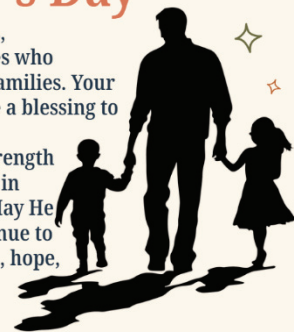

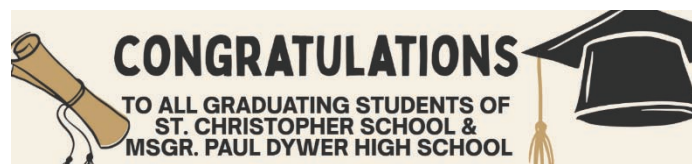
